Our Early Years Philosophy

The Early Years provision at Wellington College International Pune is firmly rooted in the **Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS)** framework, delivering a **high-quality, education-led** model that balances academic foundations with play-based and experiential learning.

Global educational research consistently highlights that high-quality early education delivers long-term benefits in:

- Early numeracy
- Academic achievement and wellbeing

Research from the **Education Endowment Foundation, University of Oxford, and OECD** reinforces that effective Early Years education is **education-led**, not childcare-led – combining skilled educators, intentional teaching, and play-based learning within a clear framework.

The EYFS provides the building blocks for a child's entire educational journey.

From Pre-Nursery through to Year 13, the learning behaviours developed in the early years directly influence:

- Engagement and motivation for learning
- Language development and communication
- Independence, self-regulation, and executive functioning
- Confidence, resilience, and problem-solving
- Positive attitudes towards challenge and achievement

Early Years at Wellington is not a standalone phase, but the **foundation upon which whole-school success is built.**

REGISTRATION FEE (Non-refundable)

₹15,000 (Fifteen Thousands Rupees only).

Payable at the time of submission of the application.

ADMISSIONS REGISTRATION FEE (Non-refundable)

₹1,00,000 (One Lakh Rupees only*).

SECURITY DEPOSIT (Refundable)

₹50,000 (Fifty Thousand Rupees only**).

#Term Fees (₹)

Parents can opt to pay the School Fees in three Terms - Term-I, Term-II and Term-III.

##Monthly Fees (₹)

Parents can opt to pay the School Fees on a monthly basis between August to June.

Fee Discounts

All the below discounts are applicable only on the Tuition Fees.

Corporate Discount:

Applicable to corporate groups enrolling students under the following categories.

Up to 4 pupils	5%
5 to 19 pupils	10%
20 pupils and above	15%

Siblings Discount:

The siblings discount is applicable only when two or more siblings are enrolled and is not applicable to a single child. The discount will be applicable on the lower fee of the siblings.

1st Child (eldest/first enrolled)	No discount
2nd Child	10%
3rd Child onwards	15%

Note:

If any student is eligible for both the sibling discount and the corporate discount, the higher of the two will be applicable.

Annual Fee Payment:

An additional 2% discount will be applied on one-time annual fee payment in advance before the start of Term I.

Parent of Indian Origin:

A parent of Indian Origin holding a valid PIO or OCI card, would be eligible for the Indian Passport Holder fee.

For Parents opting to pay fees on a monthly basis, all invoicing will be for the full month. Please note that no partial payments will be accepted irrespective of the number of school operational days in that month.

- All the fees due to Wellington College International Pune are in Indian Rupees (₹).
- All fees are payable in advance of each of the three Terms or Monthly, if opted, and are billed in accordance with the School's billing calendar as above.
- For families paying fees on a termly basis and for pupils joining the school after the start of Term, a pro-rata fee, as per the school norms, shall be applicable. Further details are available upon request.

- Late payment charges, including all related administration and legal costs, are applicable on all invoices not paid by the due date until the date of realisation of payment.
- The fees include all the costs incurred in the usual course of education by the School including provision of any necessary educational materials, unless otherwise notified to you by the School at any time (either in the Fee Structure or otherwise).
- One Term's notice is required if you wish to withdraw your child from school.
- Please see the school's Terms & Conditions (under 'Notice Requirements') for further information on the process of student withdrawal.

Supplemental Charges:

Any items charged to you in addition to the fees are termed as Supplemental Charges.

Items not covered in the above fee are:

- Uniform
- Optional Health Insurance
- Expenses incurred if the School assists in procuring the Visa for study in India
- Some trips, visits and some co-curricular activities

Payment Options
